



Warning signs during your pregnancy

If you encounter any of these symptoms, please bring them to the attention of your provider. At Women's Healthcare of Illinois, we have a 24-hour answering service (708-425-1907) to address these symptoms during pregnancy:

- Constant vomiting (more than occasional "morning sickness")
- Vaginal bleeding of any amount
- Severe headache
- Blurred or double vision or spots before your eyes
- Excessive swelling of face, hands, or eyelids
- Abnormal vaginal discharge that itches or has a bad odor
- Genital sores
- Sharp or continuous abdominal pain
- Sudden gush of watery fluid from the vagina
- Urinating frequently in small amounts accompanied by pain, burning, and urgency
- Decreased movement of your baby
- Chills and/or fever over 100.4 degrees
- Signs of preterm labor ... regular contractions or cramping before 35 weeks
- Severe or worsening depression
- Anything that seems unusual or serious to you
